## CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NEWMARKET BYLAW 1990-79

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE OBSTRUCTION OR ENCUMBERING OF HIGHWAYS OR BRIDGES UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE TOWN OF NEWMARKET.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to prohibit the obstruction or encumbering of highways or bridges under the jurisdiction of the Town of Newmarket;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket as follows:

- 1. The provisions of this bylaw shall apply to all highways and bridges under the jurisdiction of the Town of Newmarket.
- 2. The obstructing, encumbering, injuring or fouling of any highway or bridge is prohibited.
- 3. No person shall place anything calculated to obstruct any highway or bridge or obstruct or interfere with public travel on any such highway or bridge.
- 4. Every person who has so placed or deposited any such thing upon a highway or bridge shall remove such thing from the highway or bridge within twenty-four hours after receiving notice to remove such thing.
- 5. Every person who contravenes a provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for each offence.
- 6. Bylaw 1972-30 is hereby repealed.
