Please place the ring on the $3^{ m rd}$ finger of the left hand.
Municipal Clerk to the 1st person: Repeat after me, please.
"With this ring, I thee wed. I shall love, honour and cherish thee and this
ring is the symbol of my love."

Municipal Clerk to the 2<sup>nd</sup> person: Repeat after me please.

"With this ring I thee wed, I shall love, honour, and cherish thee, and this ring is the symbol of my love."
