COMMENTS

The purpose of this information report is to advise Members of Council that the Town has received a noise exemption request from the Fortis Group from Noise By-law (By-law 2004-94) to complete work at Upper Canada Mall's new entrance facing Yonge Street. The work will commence immediately and will be completed by December 22, 2017. During this period Fortis Group is requesting a noise exemption from the by-law for night work that may take place periodically between 10:00 pm to 7:00 am when construction noise is prohibited.

The work carried out by Fortis Group will include equipment such as scissor/boom lifts, welding torches, screw guns and drills.

Noise exemptions are normally granted by Council; however, due to the time sensitivity, staff will be approving the request in accordance with past practices. In accordance with the Procedure Bylaw any Members of Council may request an Information Report to be placed on an upcoming Committee of the Whole agenda for discussion.


To date the Town has not received any noise complaints regarding this project. If complaints are received regarding this exemption, staff will bring a report back to Council.
