COMMENTS

The purpose of this information report is to advise Members of Council that the Town has received a noise exemption request from the resident at 958 Creebridge Crescent. The resident has reached out to Councillor Vegh regarding this exemption. The request is for an exemption from the Noise By-law 2004-94 on Saturday July 15, 2017 starting 7:00 pm and finishing at 11:00 pm.

The Noise By-law restricts the operation of a radio or other electronic devices including any amplification device or any musical or other sound producing instrument.

In accordance with the Procedure By-law, any Members of Council may request an Information Report to be placed on an upcoming Committee of the Whole agenda for discussion.

The resident will also be preparing a notice to the surrounding community to advise of the gathering taking place at 958 Creebridge Crescent as this is part of the standard approval process.

A By-law will be placed on the upcoming Council meeting on June 26, 2017 for Council approval.


