COMMENTS

The purpose of this information report is to advise Members of Council that the Town has received a noise exemption request from the Region of York, regarding the work to take place at the intersection of Leslie Street and Mulock Drive. The request is for an exemption from the Noise Bylaw 2004-94 starting the week of June 11th and may need to be extend until June 16th from 9:00 pm to 7:00 am for the top course paving.

The Region's request is to undertake the work at non-peak hours (9:00 p.m. through 7:00 a.m.) when the traffic is less congested so as to minimize disruption to residents. Starting on June 11th the project is only supposed to take one day but are requesting the whole week in case of rain delays.

The Noise By-law restricts the operation of construction equipment or the conduct of any alteration or repair of any building between the 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. Monday through Friday and 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.


A By-law will be placed on the upcoming Council meeting on June 6, 2017 for Council approval.
