CHRISTMAS TREE PICK-UP

Christmas tree pick-up will take place on your regularly scheduled waste pick-up date from **January 3 to 6** and **January 17 to 20**. Please remove all decorations and place the tree at the curb (not on top of a snow bank) by 7 a.m. If the tree is larger than 1.8m, cut it into pieces to dispose of.

- Make sure waste bins are accessible to the waste collectors
- Make sure waste bins are not on top of or behind snow banks

TAKE EXTRA CAUTION AROUND LAKES, STREAMS, RIVERS AND STORMWATER PONDS

Take caution around local bodies of water such as Fairy Lake, the Holland River and stormwater ponds. **Stormwater ponds may look safe but water flow and levels can fluctuate quickly without warning. Please do not skate on stormwater ponds.**

Residents and community members are reminded that Newmarket parks are not maintained for winter activities (skiing, tobogganing, skibobbing, snowboarding). Please take extra caution and use at your own risk.

LIVING WITH WILDLIFE: COYOTES

Prevent encounters with coyotes by:

- Removing food attractants from your property
- Storing all garbage in tightly sealed containers
- Using motion sensitive lights in your yard
- Ensuring spaces around decks or sheds are closed off
