2022 INTERIM TAX BILLS

The 2022 Interim Tax Bills have been mailed out and residents should see them arrive in their mailboxes soon. The interim tax bill is an estimate to collect approximately 50 per cent of the total amount of your 2022 property tax in three installments. Final bills will be mailed out in June 2022. The property tax due dates are, February 25, March 25 and April 25. We offer multiple ways to pay for your property taxes.

TAKE EXTRA CAUTION AROUND STREAMS, RIVERS AND STORMWATER PONDS

Take caution around local bodies of water such as Fairy Lake, the Holland River and storm water ponds. Use extreme caution and advise your children not to skate, fish, swim or toboggan in these areas.

Stormwater ponds may look safe but water flow and levels can fluctuate quickly without warning. Please do not skate on stormwater ponds

SAFETY TIPS FOR TOBOGGANING IN NEWMARKET PARKS

Residents are reminded that parks are not maintained for winter activities. Please take extra caution, use at your own risk. Should you choose to toboggan, please follow the safety guidelines below.

- Check the hill. Make sure it is free of hazards (trees, rocks, fences, bumps) and away from roads and rivers
- Avoid ice-covered areas
- Make sure there is room at the bottom of the hill to stop – away from roads, or bodies of water
- Use proper sliding equipment and wear a helmet (ski helmets are recommended)
- Ensure your route is clear before sliding
- Ensure all children are supervised by an adult
- Try to maintain 6ft./2m. at all times from others to prevent the spread of COVID-19


COVID-19 VACCINATION INFORMATION
