## Observing outdoor burning restrictions

### Simple rules for a safe summer

**NEWMARKET, ON, June 23, 2016** – With the warmer weather upon us the Central York Fire Services (CYFS) reminds residents to stay safe when having outdoor fires by following Newmarket and Aurora’s outdoor burning restrictions and by-laws.

When having an outdoor fire on your private property, please keep the following “Do’s” and “Don’ts” in mind:

Do	Don't
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Contain the fire in a chiminea, a fire pit or an outdoor oven to control the spread of the flames. Remember to keep all containers on level ground and off of combustible surfaces such as a wooden deck</li> <li>• Create a safe distance (at least 13 feet) between the fire and your home, lot lines, trees, fences and vehicles</li> <li>• Keep your fire small (under 30 inches in diameter and 40 inches in height).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Let your outdoor fire burn between 11 p.m. and 8 a.m.</li> <li>• Have an outdoor fire during a fire ban</li> <li>• Burn any noxious or treated materials, garbage or yard waste.</li> <li>• Use any Flying Lanterns/Sky Lanterns</li> </ul>

Remember to have an adult over the age of 18 present at all times while the fire is burning, and keep a garden hose with an open valve within reach during every outdoor fire.
